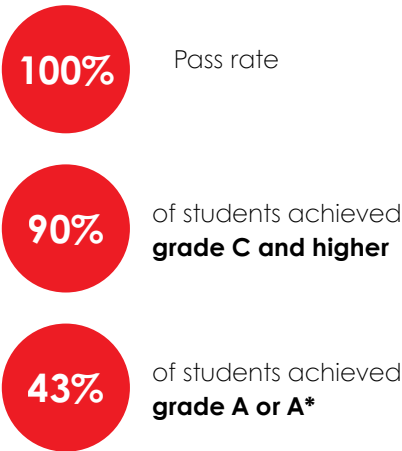

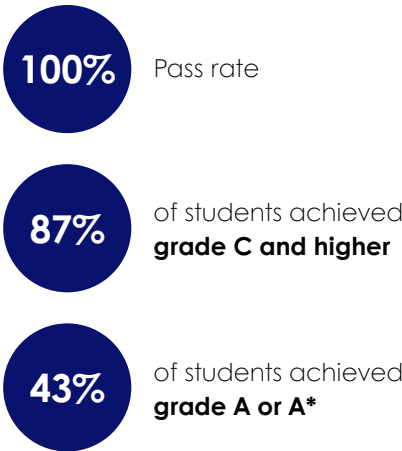
- St. Andrews S107 offers an extensive range of extra-curricular activities from Monday to Thursday.

◆ International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBDP) Curriculum

- **Subjects:** Six subjects, with three at Higher Level (240 hours each) and three at Standard Level (150 hours each).
 - Choose one subject from each of the six groups: Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics and the Arts (or a second subject from Individuals and Societies or Sciences).
- **Core Components:**
 - Theory of Knowledge (TOK): Critical evaluation of knowledge through an exhibition and essay.
 - Extended Essay (EE): A 4,000-word independent research project.
 - Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS): Engagement in extracurricular activities.
- **Grading:**
 - Subjects are graded on a scale of 1 (lowest) to 7 (highest).
 - Up to 3 bonus points for TOK and EE.
 - Maximum score: 45 points (42 from subjects + 3 core points).
 - Pass mark: A minimum of 24 points, subject to specific conditions for the core components and subject grades.

◆ International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (IBCP)

- **IBCP:** A two-year programme combining IB principles with career-focused learning.
- **Course Structure:**
 - At least three IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) courses
 - IBCP core components
 - Career-related studies
- **Career-related Studies (CRS) Options:**
 - Pearson BTEC International Level 3 in Business: Five mandatory units and four optional units
 - Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University: Dual-enrolment pathway in Aviation
- **Assessment:**
 - IBDP courses: Externally assessed by IB examiners
 - IBCP core: Internally assessed; the Reflective Project is externally moderated
 - CRS: Assessed through ongoing written assignments over two years
