◆ Reporting System

- (I)GCSE, the IB Diploma Programme, the IB Career-related Programme and IB Courses are two-year progressive programmes.
- Reports are generated three times per year: two grade reports and one full written report. There is also one parent consultation evening.
- Reports evaluate students' formative attitudes to learning and summative academic progress.
- Students sit internationally recognised baseline aptitude tests: the Year Eleven Indicator System (YELLIS), between the ages of 14 and 16, and the Advanced Level Information System (ALIS). These provide data to set targets and measure progress.

◆ Predicted Grades

Predicted grades are generated in November of the final year (DP2) and reflect a comprehensive evaluation of each student's academic performance and potential. The process incorporates both quantitative and qualitative measures.

Quantitatively, teachers consider a range of evidence, including classwork, homework, in-class assessments, DP1 end-of-year examinations, DP2 mock examinations and completed Internal Assessments (IAs).

Qualitatively, predicted grades are informed by the teacher's professional judgement, taking into account the student's overall trajectory, level of engagement, consistency of effort, cognitive processing skills, reflective capacity and attitude towards inquiry within the subject. This holistic approach ensures that predicted grades accurately reflect the student's capabilities and readiness for final assessments.

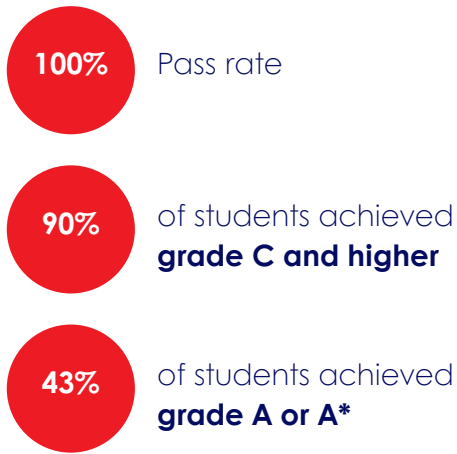
◆ Enrichment at S107

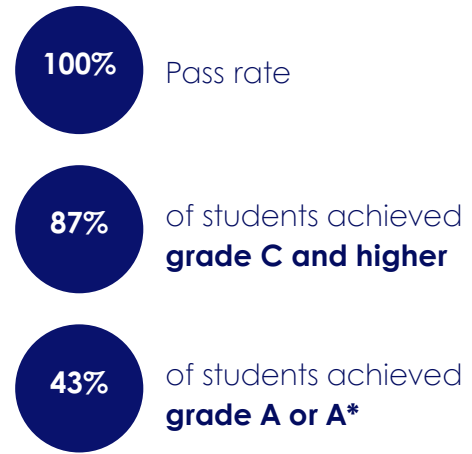
- **Community Engagement:** Collaborations with local non-governmental organisations

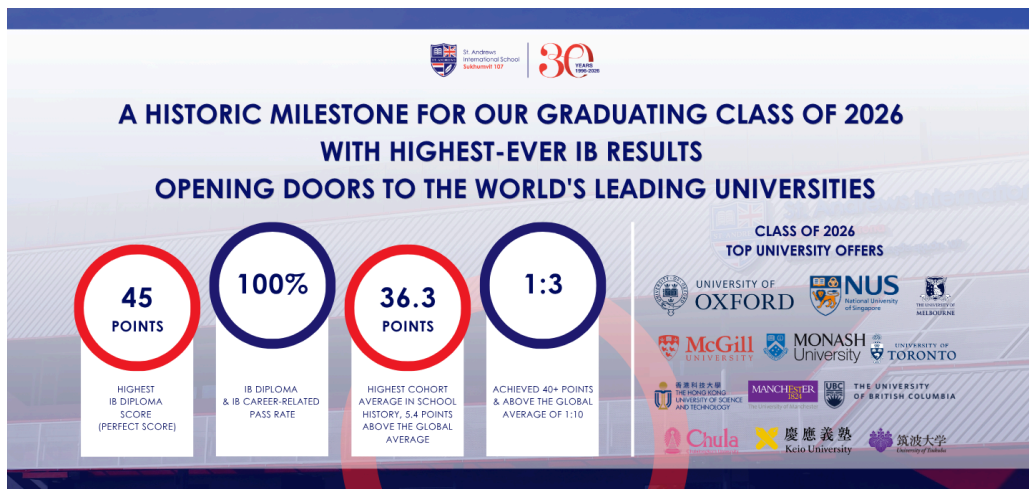

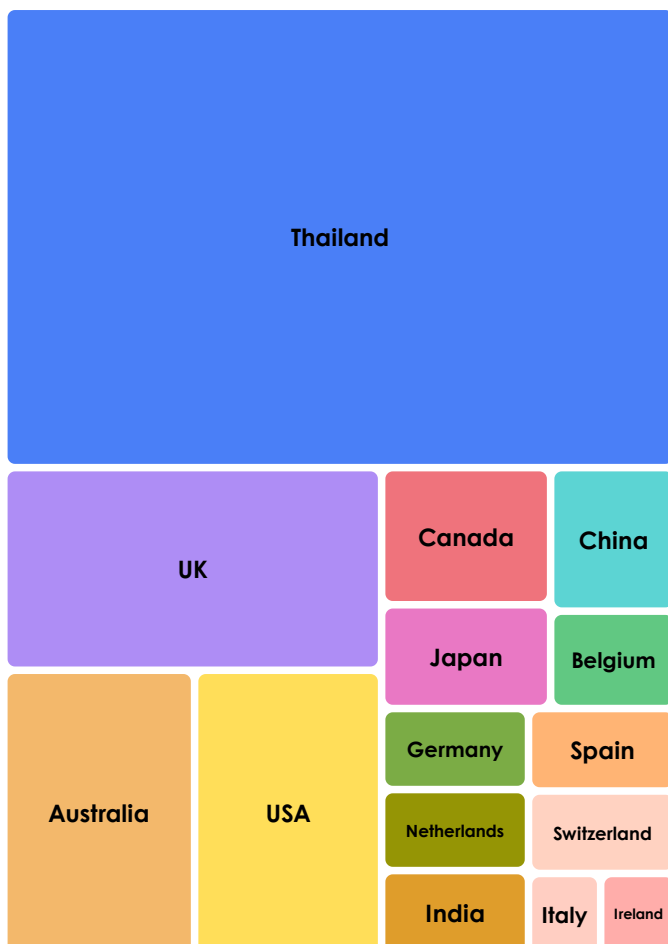
