
Would you buy second-hand uniforms if these were available?










Do you use public transport (BTS or bus - not school bus) to travel to school? 282 responses




If you don't take public transport to school what is the main reason? 206 responses








In an average week how often you eat in the school canteen? 282 responses










How often do you eat vegetarian meals from the school canteen?
